monday

Pray for the GBU-students in Brussels and in Liège. Pray they continue to be rooted in & motivated by the gospel thanks to the Bible studies which took place at GBU this past year.

Pray that God strengthens and continues to grow Christian students in the faith during the more intense period of revisions and exams.

Pray that, as they listen to His word, God continues to awaken the minds of believing students so that their priority would always be to build the house of God (the Church) rather than theirs (Hag 1.12-15).

Pray that the GBU would always be consecrated to its mission, which is to make disciples of Jesus in the student world. Pray they do this in full dependance on God.

tuesday

Pray the GBU would remain active in evangelism as they proclaim Christ crucified and resurrected faithfully, pertinently and attractively (3rd value of the GBU). Pray God would fill them with the Holy Spirit to do this with boldness (Ac 4.23-31).

Pray that the GBU & its students would be united around the essential truths of the gospel (5th value of the GBU). Pray they discern these truths and hold firmly to them!

Pray for our partnership in the work of the gospel: that staff would support the students well so that they would accomplish our mission thanks to the prayers and donations of our supporters (7th value of the GBU).

Praise God that despite the war, students in CCX Ukraine have been able to continue ministry across the country, including new weekly Bible studies, discussion clubs and other events in Kyiv, Lviv, and Ivano-Frankivsk.

wednesday

Pray for the students who are Christian, that they would be meditating God's word on a regular basis, and they wouldn't neglect the only thing that matters (Luke 10.38-42 and 1 P 2.2-3).

Pray for the testimony of Christian students - that during this period of revisions and exams, they would walk in a manner worthy of the gospel, distinct in their attachment to Christ (Eph 4.1).

Pray for the gathering where all the general secretaries of Europe are meeting. Pray they are all encouraged in the faith, as they share and pray together, and that the movements they lead serve university students faithfully, for the glory of Christ.

Pray for the prayer life of Christian students (and ours!), at this point in our lives. Pray we'd learn to become real prayer-warriors, like Epaphras, for the Christians to be strengthened in the faith (Col 4.12-13).

Pray God uses the GBU so that the gospel is proclaimed to every student in French-speaking Belgium, and that many follow Christ faithfully (the vision of the GBU).

Pray that the GBU would remain founded on the word and that they'd always seek to understand, proclaim and defend the truth of the gospel (1st value of the GBU). Pray this would be a reality in the students' lives.

Pray the GBU would persevere in discipleship, encouraging and equipping students in the faith for a life of godliness and mission (4th value of the GBU). Pray students make decisive decisions that will impact the rest of their lives !

Pray the GBU (staff and students) would always be serving the local church which is the main place of growth and service of believers (6th value of the GBU).

Thank God for the new Friends who have recently joined the GBU. Pray for these new partnerships and that more believers will commit to supporting this key ministry for students.

Thank God for all the students who were involved at GBU this year. Pray God would continue to make them grow in the faith, and that they'd persevere in the mission wherever they find themselves next year.

Praise God for the freedom Christians have in Belgium to share the gospel. Pray this freedom is maintained and that students would make the most of it to share it with more than 250,000 non-Christian students who desperately

Pray for Tanzanian students, supporters, and staff who took part in a 22-day Bible reading challenge in Revelation to be inspired and encouraged to share their faith.

Thank God for opportunities to rebuild Tongan campus ministry in the wake of some difficult years. Pray for Sam Hala'ufia, who returned to Tonga in January to replant PSCF.

Pray that God will use UGBB Burkina Faso's theme, "mission and resilience", to encourage and empower students in a context of war. Pray already for their national missions convention in August.

Pray God continues to give wisdom to the Board of GBU, to make decisions that strengthen the ministry in order to achieve the vision of the GBU.

4 Pray that, motivated by grace, we work together for God because of the gospel of Christ (2nd value of the GBU). Pray His grace would always train us to live for him in a godly way for his glory (Titus 2.11-14).

Pray for our financial needs as GBU appoints a new full time staff worker. Pray God provides through brothers and sisters so that we can see more and more students know Jesus and make him known to others.

Thank God for the students-leaders and all those who were involved in the GBU this year. Pray they continue to grow in the faith, and pray that we can find new leaders for next year.

Pray that the students persevere in making Christ known to their friends, even during the more intense period at the end of the year, not being ashamed of the gospel (Rom 1.16)!

Thank God for the elders/pastors of your church. Pray God sustains those who are facing difficulties (personal ones or complicated pastoral care).

Thank God for the elders/pastors of the student churches', and pray that they will shepherd his flock in a way that honors him. Pray these young people will be committed to a local church, and that they will submit humbly to their leaders (1 Peter 5.5-7).

Pray for the churches that are seeking to gather whilst in a context of war. Pray the word of God is preached through various formats so that our brothers and sisters grow up into salvation (1 P 2.2-3).

Pray for our church-leaders to whom God has given the responsibility of caring for and feeding his flock. Pray that He gives them wisdom, strength and joy, and that they'd be workers who have no need to be ashamed.

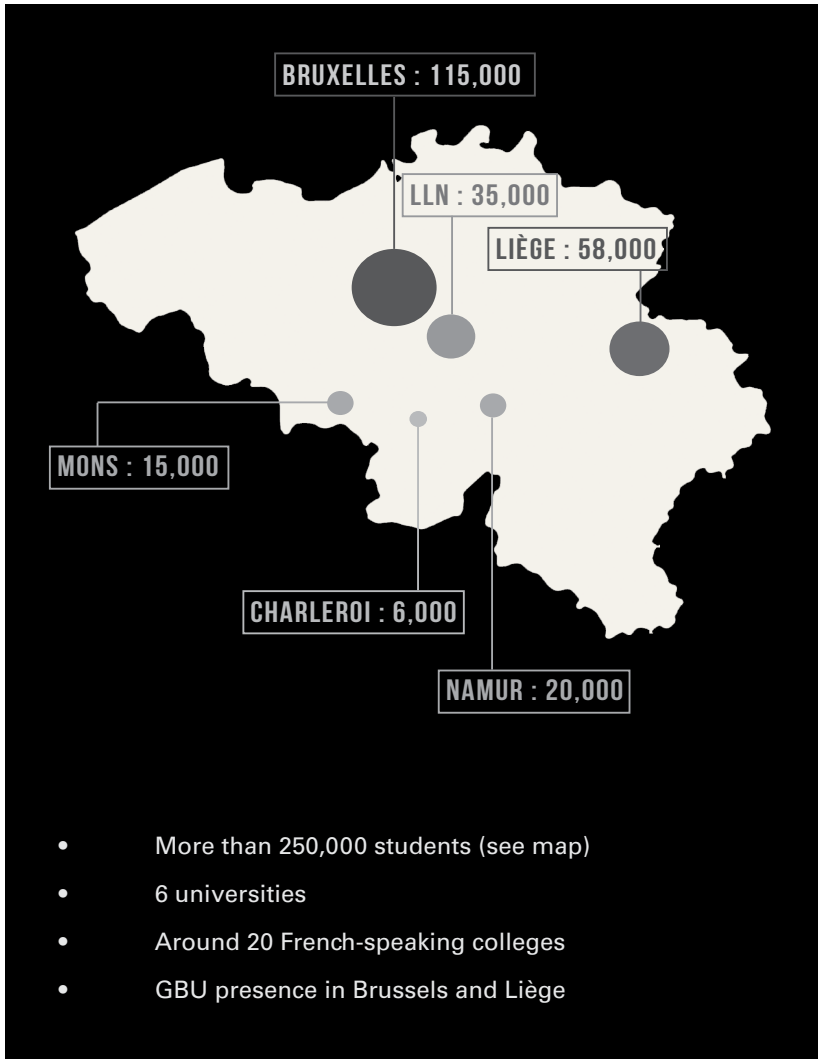
